

Volunteer Job Description

Hospitality Attendant

Position Summary:

Dining room attendants will be present during lunch and/or dinner and will help to ensure the sponsor dining room is stocked with drinks and ice, bus tables, pull trash, and help maintain the cleanliness while sponsors are present.

Responsibilities:

- Assist beverage attendant to ensure drinks are stocked and properly iced during lunch/dinner
- Set up and clean before guests arrival
- · Clean up and bus tables as needed as sponsors finish lunch/dinner
- Assist caterer to ensure buffet line is stocked and clean
- Clean up dining room when lunch/dinner concludes
- Notify beverage attendant if drinks are needed in dining room or go get additional drinks if beverage attendant is unavailable.

Skills Needed:

 Outgoing and courteous personality with the ability to interact with sponsors as they arrive in the sponsor dining room to eat lunch and/or dinner

Requirements:

- Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time
- Ability to lift up to 10 pounds
- Ability to bend over to pick up items
- Must be comfortable/willing to do the responsibilities listed above

Training:

Volunteers will be trained at the beginning of their shift. Event staff will explain specific details for this position upon arrival.

Event schedules and tasks vary based on event needs. While volunteers may sign up for a specific task, event staff reserve the right to reassign volunteer positions to fill event gaps.
