Zachary Svajda is an emerging talent in American tennis, recognized for his smooth groundstrokes and composure on court. He gained national attention by winning the USTA Boys' 18s National Championship twice, in 2019 and 2021, earning him wild cards into the US Open. Svajda's transition to the professional circuit has been impressive, with strong performances in several Challenger tournaments. In 2024, he claimed his first ATP Challenger title in Tiburon, California, solidifying his reputation as a player to watch as he continues to rise through the ranks.



Ethan Quinn (USA)

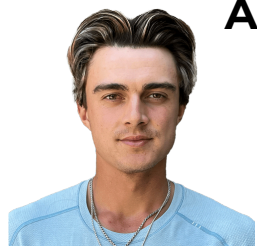

The University of Tennessee alumni is back in Knoxville pursuing another ATP Challenger Tour title. With both singles and doubles titles under his belt, Walton is considered a dual threat. He will be coming into Knoxville with a singles rank of 102 and doubles rank of 176. Walton had a successful kickoff to 2024, winning the Burnie Challenger title and making it to the finals of the Pune Challenger. He has maintained that energy through the year, recently claiming his third Challenger title in Taipei City, Taiwan, defeating Illya Marchenko (C.H. 49) in the finals.
